Mean Gender Pay Gap

- Women's mean hourly rate is 32.2% higher than men's
 - In other words when comparing mean hourly rates, women earn £1.32 for every £1 that men earn

Median Gender Pay Gap

- Women's median hourly rate is 0.4% higher than men's
 - In other words when comparing median hourly rates, women earn the same as men.

Mean Bonus Gender Pay Gap

• Women's mean bonus pay is 22.8% lower than men's

Median Bonus Gender Pay Gap

• Women's median bonus pay is 71.4% higher than men's

Proportion of Males and Females receiving a Bonus Payment

- 19.5% of women
- 7.1% of men
